# Licensed Vocational Nursing Program

## Program Description

This is a 12-month nursing program for the student to be trained as an entry-level licensed vocational nurse. It is a full-time commitment. Upon successful completion, students will be eligible to take the NCLEX-PN® examination.

Enrollment for the LVN program takes place twice a year. This program is accredited by the Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians.

## Admission Qualifications

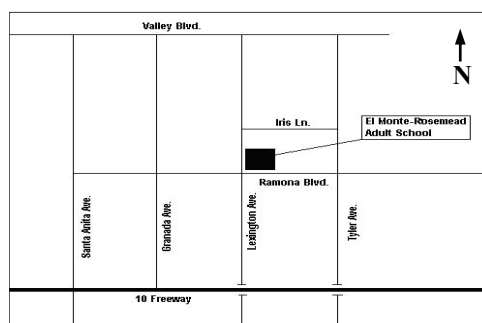
- Must be at least eighteen (18) years old.
- Provide proof of a high school diploma or GED certificate from an accredited school.
- Pass the LVN entrance examination.
- Pre-requisite: Advanced Medical Terminology from the El Monte-Rosemead Adult School **OR** Medical Terminology from any community college.
- Current cost is: \$3,100.00 (*amount subject to unannounced changes*).
- Selected applicants must attend a 16-hour Pre-LVN class.

## Date of next class: September, 2011 (exact start date to be announced)

- Return application with fee (\$20.00) to Medical Occupations Office and be scheduled for LVN entrance examination.
- Deadline to submit application is: Tuesday, March 15, 2011, or until entrance exam spaces are filled.
- Dates are subject to unannounced changes, confirmation recommended.
