Licensed Vocational Nursing Program

Program Description

This is a 12-month nursing program for the student to be trained as an entry-level licensed vocational nurse. It is a full-time commitment. Upon successful completion, students will be eligible to take the NCLEX-PN® examination.

Enrollment for the LVN program takes place twice a year. This program is accredited by the Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians.

Admission Qualifications

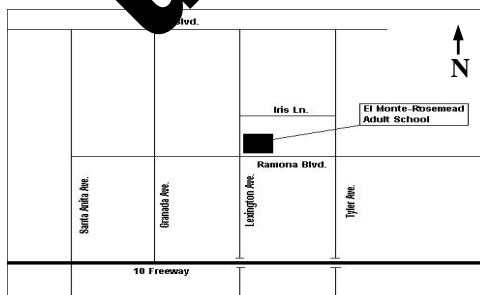
- Must be at least eighteen (18) years old.
- Provide proof of a high school diploma or GED certificate from an accredited school.
- Pass the LVN entrance examination.
- Pre-requisite: Advanced Medical Terminology from El Monte-Rosemead Adult School **OR** Medical Terminology from an accredited college.
- Current cost is: \$3,500.00 (amount is subject to unannounced changes).
- Selected applicants must attend a 16-hour Pre-LVN class.

Date of next class: Fall, 2011

- Pick up application form at the Medical Occupations Office, Ramona Adult Center or an application can be printed from EMRAS on one page.
 - Pay application fee (\$20.00) at EMRAS Ramona Center bookstore.
 - Return application with fee receipt to Medical Occupations Office and be scheduled for LVN entrance examination.
- Deadline to submit application is Wednesday, February 29, 2012, **OR** until entrance exam spaces are filled.
- Dates are subject to unannounced changes, confirmation recommended.
